#### ANNUAL EEO PUBLIC FILE REPORT

Section 3: Supplemental (Non-Vacancy Specific) Recruitment Activities Undertaken by Stations KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD:

# KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD HAVE ACHIEVED BROAD OUTREACH THROUGH THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS:

- 1. KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD is co-sponsoring a job fair with Marshalltown Community College/Iowa Valley Continuing Education and IowaWORKS. This job fair was to be held on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 but is currently postponed due to Covid-19 restrictions. All management personnel of KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD, specifically Mark Osmundson and John Wirkler, participated in the planning sessions and decision making processes for this job fair. KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM AND KTDV-FM also donated over 25 hours of combined air time to promoting this event to encourage employers to have booths at the job fair and the general public to attend the job fair. Due to restrictions put in place by the state of Iowa regarding Covid-19, the job fair was postponed on March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and remains postponed at this time due to continuing Covid-19 restrictions. KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD will staff a booth at the job fair when it is held.
- 2. Mark Osmundson, CEO and General Manager of KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD, serves on the Board of Directors of the Iowa Broadcasters' Association Foundation. During the Applicable Period, two students in the University of Northern Iowa Digital Media Communications Studies program received \$4,000 scholarships to continue their education at that college. Mr. Osmundson served on the scholarship selection committee and as a Foundation Board Member, he was involved in approving the scholarship awards presented to the two successful candidates.

While the group was at the stations, Mr. Wirkler also explained how the stations operate and informed the students about careers available in broadcasting.

On February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020, Station Manager, John Wirkler of KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD, allowed the speech class from the Meskwaki Settlement School to use the stations' production facilities to prepare their group radio presentation for the State of Iowa State Speech Contest. Mr. Wirkler again gave vocal instruction advice and helped the group record and organize their program.
